Proposal for Millage to Purchase and Maintain Emergency Vehicles and other Equipment

Proposal for Millage to Purchase and Maintain Emergency Vehicles

This proposal will permit the Authority Board to levy up to .5 mills for the purpose of providing funds for the purchase and maintenance of emergency vehicles and other equipment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property within the territorial limits of the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority, which is composed of Banks Township, Echo Township, and Jordan Township, Antrim County, Michigan, and the City of East Jordan and South Arm Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan, be increased by up to fifty cents (\$.50) per thousand dollars (\$1,000) (.5 mills) of the taxable value on all taxable property within the territorial limits of the Authority for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the purchase and maintenance of emergency vehicles and other equipment for the Authority, and shall the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority Board be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$211,979 for the Authority in 2024.

Proposal for Ambulance Operating Millage

This proposal will permit the Authority Board to levy up to 1.25 mills for the purpose of providing funds for operating and maintaining ambulance services.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property within the territorial limits of the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority, which is composed of Banks Township, Echo Township, and Jordan Township, Antrim County, Michigan, and the City of East Jordan and South Arm Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan, be increased by up to one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) per thousand dollars (\$1,000) (1.25 mills) of the taxable value on all taxable property within the territorial limits of the Authority for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for operating and maintaining ambulance services within the territorial limits of the Authority, and shall the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority Board be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$529,947 for the Authority in 2024.

Proposal for Millage to Purchase and Maintain Emergency Vehicles and other Equipment

This proposal will permit the Authority Board to levy up to .5 mills for the purpose of providing funds for the purchase and maintenance of emergency vehicles and other equipment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property within the territorial limits of the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority, which is composed of Banks Township, Echo Township, and Jordan Township, Antrim County, Michigan, and the City of East Jordan and South Arm Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan, be increased by up to fifty cents (\$.50) per thousand dollars (\$1,000) (.5 mills) of the taxable value on all taxable property within the territorial limits of the Authority for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the purchase and maintenance of emergency vehicles and other equipment for the Authority, and shall the Jordan Valley Emergency Medical Service Authority Board be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$211,979 for the Authority in 2024.

CHARLEVOIX COUNTY PROPOSAL

Proposal to Renew Countywide Road Millage

This proposal reestablishes the 1 mill road millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan, against taxable property in the County be increased by up to 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of 14 years, 2024 through 2037, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for rebuilding and paving existing roads and streets within the cities, village, and unincorporated areas of Charlevoix County, and shall the Charlevoix County Board of Commissioners be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$2,962,615 in 2024 that will be disbursed to the Charlevoix County Road Commission, the Cities of Boyne City, Charlevoix, and East Jordan, and the Village of Boyne Falls pursuant to the formula specified in MCL 224.20b(2).

Proposal to Renew Grandvue Millage

This proposal reestablishes the .75 mills for Grandvue previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. The Headlee Amendment previously reduced this millage to .7334 mills. This ballot proposal renews the existing .7334 mills and restores the .0166 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan, against taxable property in the County be increased by up to .75 mills (\$.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of Grandvue Medical Care Facility, and shall the Charlevoix County Board of Commissioners be authorized to levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$2,221,962 in 2024 that will be disbursed to Grandvue Medical Care Facility.

Proposal to Renew Recycling Millage

This proposal reestablishes the .15 mills recycling millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current .1466 mills that was last levied and restores the .0034 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan, against taxable property in the County be increased by up to .15 mills (\$.15 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for recycling services within the county, including capital purchases, and shall the Charlevoix County Board of Commissioners be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$444,392 for Charlevoix County in 2024.

Proposal to Renew Senior Millage

This proposal reestablishes the .65 mills senior millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current .6356 mills that was last levied and restores the .0144 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan, against taxable property in the County be increased by up to .65 mills (\$.65 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for senior citizen services within the county, including capital improvements at the senior centers, and shall the Charlevoix County Board of Commissioners be authorized to levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$1,925,700 for Charlevoix County in 2024.

BOYNE VALLEY TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Road Improvement Millage Increase

Shall Boyne Valley Township impose an increase of up to 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, to provide funds for the improvement, construction, and maintenance of roads within Boyne Valley Township, which 1.5 mills increase will raise an estimated \$315,000 in 2024.

Ambulance Millage Renewal

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Boyne Valley Township, of 1.00 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 0.9944 mills (\$0.9944 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 1.00 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for four years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for equipping, operating, and maintaining an ambulance service within the Township, raising an estimated \$192,078.90 in 2024.

CHANDLER TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Proposal For Fire and EMS Millage

This proposal will permit the Township to levy up to 1.75 mills for the purpose of providing funds for fire protection and EMS services.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Chandler, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to 1.75 mills (\$1.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for fire protection and EMS services, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$23,948 for the Township when first levied in 2024.

EVANGELINE TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Proposal to Renew Road Millage

This proposal reestablishes the 2 mills road millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the previously levied 1.9213 mills and restores the .0787 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Evangeline, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for road construction and maintenance, and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$219,868 for the Township in 2024.

Proposal for Fire and Ambulance Millage

This proposal will permit the Township to levy up to .9 mills for the purpose of providing funds for fire protection and ambulance services.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Evangeline, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to .9 mills (\$.90 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for fire protection and ambulance services, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$98,940 for the Township in 2024.

HAYES TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Proposal to Renew Road Millage

This proposal renews the 1 mill road millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Hayes, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the township be increased by up to one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for road repair and maintenance, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$245,596.41 for the Township in 2024.

MARION TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Referendum on Zoning Ordinance Amendment

Shall Ordinance No. 5 of 2023 which amends the Marion Township Zoning Ordinance to rezone an approximately 90 acre parcel owned by SOP Holdings, LLC from the Agricultural (A) zoning district to the Mobile Home Park (MH) zoning district be approved and take effect?

MELROSE TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Proposal to Renew Ambulance Millage

This proposal reestablishes the .25 mill ambulance millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current .2463 mills that was last levied and restores the .0037 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Melrose, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to .25 mills (\$.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for ambulance services, and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$57,200 for the Township in 2024.

Proposal to Renew Road Millage

This proposal reestablishes the 1 mill road millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current .9855 mills that was last levied and restores the .0145 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of Melrose, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for road construction and maintenance, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$228,800 for the Township in 2024.

PEAINE TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Operational Millage Renewal

This proposal will permit Peaine Township to renew the Township's 4 mills for the general operation of the Township previously approved by the electors, which expired after the December 2023 levy.

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Peaine Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan, of up to 4 mills (\$4.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), be renewed up to the original voted 4 mills (\$4.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 5 years, 2024 through 2028 inclusive, on all taxable property in Peaine Township for the purpose of providing funds for the general operation of the Township? If approved and levied in full, this renewal millage would generate an estimated \$348,241 in revenue for the general operation of Peaine Township when first levied in 2024.

Fire Protection Millage Renewal

This proposal will permit Peaine Township to renew the Township's 1 mill for providing funds for fire protection in the Township previously approved by the electors, which expired after the December 2023 levy.

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Peaine Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan, of up to 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), be renewed up to the original voted 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 5 years, 2024 through 2028 inclusive, on all taxable property in Peaine Township for the purpose of providing funds for fire protection in the Township? If approved and levied in full, this renewal millage would generate an estimated \$87,060 in revenue for Peaine Township when first levied in 2024 a portion of which may be disbursed to the Beaver Island Emergency Services Authority as the Township Board determines appropriate.

Transfer Station Millage Renewal

This proposal will permit Peaine Township to renew the Township's 2 mills for the operation of the township waste transfer station previously approved by the electors, which expired after the December 2023 levy.

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Peaine Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan, of up to 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), be renewed to the original voted 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 5 years, 2024 through 2028 inclusive, on all taxable property in Peaine Township for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of the township transfer station? If approved and levied in full, this renewal millage would generate an estimated \$174,121 in revenue for Peaine Township when first levied in 2024 of which a portion may be disbursed to units of local government as the Township Board determines appropriate.

Medical Center Millage Renewal

This proposal will permit Peaine Township to restore the Township's 2 mills for providing funds for the operation of the island's medical center previously approved by the electors, which expired after the December 2023 levy. This ballot proposal renews the existing 2 mills.

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Peaine Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan, of up to 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), be renewed up to 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 5 years, 2024-2028 inclusive, on all taxable property in Peaine Township for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of the island's medical center. If approved and levied in full, this renewal millage would generate an estimated \$174,121 in revenue for Peaine Township to finance the operation of the island's medical center when first levied in 2024.

SOUTH ARM TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Proposal to Renew Fire Millage

This proposal reestablishes the .75 mill fire millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current .7208 mills that was last levied and restores the .0292 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of South Arm, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to .75 mills (\$0.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for fire protection, and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$103,962 for the Township when first levied in 2024.

ST. JAMES TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL

Proposal to Renew Operations Millage

This proposal reestablishes the 3.25 mill general operations millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current 3.2184 mills that was authorized to be last levied and restores the .0316 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Township of St. James, County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan be increased by up to three dollars twenty-five cents (\$3.25) per thousand dollars (\$1,000) (3.25 mills) of the taxable value on all taxable property in the township for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for general operations of the township, and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$194,028 for the Township in 2024.

Proposal to Renew Airport Millage

This proposal reestablishes the 1 mill airport millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current .9903 mills that was last levied and restores the .0097 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Township of St. James, County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan be increased by up to one dollar (\$1.00) per thousand dollars (\$1,000) (1 mill) of the taxable value on all taxable property in the township for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for airport operations and maintenance, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$59,701 for the Township in 2024.

Proposal to Renew Landfill and Transfer Station Millage

This proposal reestablishes the 1.75 mill landfill and transfer station millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current 1.7330 mills that was last levied and restores the .0170 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Township of St. James, County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan be increased by up to one dollar seventy-five cents (\$1.75) per thousand dollars (\$1,000) (1.75 mills) of the taxable value on all taxable property in the township for four (4) years, 2024 through 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the operation and maintenance of the landfill and transfer station, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$104,476 for the Township in 2024.

Proposal to Renew EMS Millage

This proposal reestablishes the 3 mills EMS millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current 2.9709 mills that was last authorized to be levied and restores the .0291 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of St. James, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to 3 mills (\$3.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for Advance Life Support services and general operations of emergency medical services, and shall the Township levy such millage for these purposes? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$179,103 for the Township in 2024.

Proposal to Renew Historical Society Millage

This proposal reestablishes the .25 mill Historical Society millage previously approved by the electors that expired after the December, 2023 levy. Specifically, the proposal renews the current .2475 mills that was last levied and restores the .0025 mills previously rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be levied by the Township of St. James, Charlevoix County, Michigan, against taxable property in the Township be increased by up to .25 mills (\$.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four (4) years, 2024 through 2027, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of the Beaver Island Historical Society, and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated \$14,925 for the Township in 2024.

CHARLEVOIX PUBLIC LIBRARY PROPOSAL

Library Millage Proposal

Shall the Charlevoix Public Library, County of Charlevoix, Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed .80 mill (\$.80 for each \$1,000 of taxable value), of which .6143 mill is a renewal of the millage rate that expires in 2024 and .1857 mill is new additional millage, against all taxable property within the Charlevoix Public Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2025 to 2034, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Charlevoix Public Library will collect in the first year of levy (2025) if the millage is approved and levied by the Library is approximately \$845,000. By law, a portion of the revenue from the millage may be subject to capture by the Charlevoix County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority.

CHARLEVOIX COUNTY / CITY OF CHARLEVOIX, TOWNSHIP OF HAYES, TOWNSHIP OF CHARLEVOIX RECREATIONAL AUTHORITY PROPOSAL

Millage Proposal

This proposal will authorize the City of Charlevoix, Township of Hayes, Township of Charlevoix Recreational Authority to levy 0.3333 mill for the purpose of providing funds for operating, maintaining, and improving the Charlevoix Area Community Pool. Of the 0.3333 mill, 0.3171 mill represents a renewal of the 0.3333 mill authorization approved by the electors of the territory comprising the Authority in 2014 which will expire with the 2024 levy, and 0.0162 mill represents a restoration of that portion of the same authorization which has been reduced by application of the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the limitation-on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the territory of the City of Charlevoix, Township of Hayes, Township of Charlevoix Recreational Authority, County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan, be increased by 0.3333 mill (\$0.3333 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of four years, 2025 through 2028, inclusive, as a renewal of the 0.3171 mill previously authorized by the electors which expires with the 2024 tax levy as reduced by operation of the Headlee Amendment, plus new additional millage representing a restoration of the amount equal to the amount reduced by operation of the Headlee Amendment, which was 0.0162 mill in 2024, for the purpose of providing funds for operating, maintaining, and improving the Charlevoix Area Community Pool? If approved and levied in its entirety, it is estimated that the 0.3333 mill would raise an estimated \$274,791 for the Authority when first levied in 2025.
